Concession News

We are continuing to bring in both chocolate and white milk each week. To make it easier, especially for our younger students, we are selling milk punch-cards. The punch-cards sell for \$10 and will entitle the student to purchase 15 milks. When a student wants milk, we will just hole-punch the card. We will keep the punch-cards on file in the concession.

Purchasing a punch-card will reduce the cost of milk from its normal \$.75 to about \$.66 per milk. All punch-cards will have an expiry date of June 12, 2012. The concession is selling a number of new items this year. We are selling soup (Noodle Time) for \$2.00. We also continue to sell Pizza Pops (\$1.00), Burritos (\$1.00), and Pizzas (\$1.50). Wrap Tuesday-Preorder (\$4.00), Hot dogs – Thursday, Lunch Specials – Friday – Nachos (\$2.50).
